The Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) has reviewed House Bill 629 and would like to express our support for this legislation. As a member of the Maryland Green Purchasing Committee, MDE has actively participated in the Committee's review of Environmentally Preferable Procurement as a path to complying with purchasing requirements under the Green Maryland Act. The Committee, which has broad representation of state agencies, has developed a set of specifications that will enable implementation of environmentally preferable purchasing by state units, reflecting the state's existing laws, regulations and sustainability goals. MDE believes that House Bill 629 is consistent with the goals of the Green Maryland Act, and will result in greater participation by state agencies in meeting Maryland's commitment to resource sustainability.
