Re: Letter of Support, Senate Bill 93 – Natural Resources – Recreational Incentives Pilot Program

Dear Chairperson McIntosh and Members of the Committee:

The Maryland Department of the Environment has reviewed Senate Bill 93, *Natural Resources* - *Recreational Incentives Pilot Program*, and would like to express our support for the bill and its objectives.

Senate Bill 93 would establish the Recreational Incentives Pilot Program in the Department of Natural Resources, in order to determine if incentive discounts increase the purchase of recreational hunting or fishing licenses by individuals who have not recently held licenses. Recreational fishing licenses provide an opportunity for the State to educate both prospective and current license holders with important public health information and messages, such as Maryland's fish consumption advisories, general fish consumption information, and reducing risk from waterborne hazards like *Vibrio* bacteria. Success of the Recreational Incentives Pilot Program could expand the audience who may benefit from these public health messages.
