California Code of Regulations (CCR) Emissions Warranty Coverage Periods for New Vehicles Sold in Maryland

This information outlines the general warranty requirements for products sold in Maryland. Refer to your vehicle, engine, or equipment's owners manual for the specific warranty coverage.

- Warranty Requirements for 2011 and Subsequent Model Year Passenger Cars, and Light-duty Trucks Originally Registered in Maryland. Covers Vehicles up to 14,000 lbs.
 - o California Code of Regulation (CCR) §2037: Warranty Defects
 - Covers emissions-related parts for 3 years/ 50,000 miles
 - Covers high-cost emissions-related parts for 7 years/ 70,000 miles
 - o Partial Zero Emission Vehicles (PZEV) Certified Vehicles §1962:
 - Covers emissions-related parts for 15 years/ 150,000 miles
 - Covers energy storage devices (batteries) for 10 years/ 150,000 miles
 - o Federal Emissions Warranty- EPA420-F-96-020- Covers specified major emissions control components for 8 years/ 80,000 miles. *Only applies to light-duty vehicles up to 8,500 lbs.
 - Catalytic Converters
 - Electronic Emissions Control Unit (ECU)
 - Onboard Diagnostic Device (OBD)

^{*}Warranty requirements apply to new vehicles registered in Maryland beginning with the 2011 Model Year.
