ATTENTION NEW PROCEDURE

Effective March 1, 2019, The Maryland Department of the Environment has implemented a new procedure for Interstate Certificates ("Floater").

There are three ways to submit a floater form with inspection(s).

- 1. Fax form with a signature and any relevant inspections to 410-537-4133
- 2. Scan form with a signature and any relevant inspections and email to mde.floaters@maryland.gov
- 3. Obtain electronic form from the Department's website, fill it out electronically and save, then email form with any relevant inspections to mde.floaters@maryland.gov.

Inspections MUST be included. The Department will no longer offer the option to mark that the inspection is on file.

The form must be "signed". If you fill the form our by hand then it must be signed. If you fill the form out electronically then typing the name is acceptable.

The Department will not be providing copies of the form for each floater card. The Department will continue to provide one blank copy.

To obtain the form electronically go to https://mde.maryland.gov. Click on "Land" then click on "Applications Forms and Instructions" under the Related Links section on the left. Key Things to Remember:

- Form must be completed and faxed/emailed 24 hours PRIOR to use.
- Floater form is valid for up to 5 days.
- Make sure to fill in your hauler number and which floater card the form corresponds to.
- Laminated Floater Card MUST be carried in the cab of the truck.
- Annual Inspection and, as applicable, the V, K, I and P Inspections must faxed/emailed with the form.
