**PURPOSE OF THIS NOTICE:** The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is announcing its proposed decision (Statement of Basis (SB)) for environmental remediation at the Tradepoint Atlantic Facility (TPA), (MDD053945432) under the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 provisions of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

**FACILITY DESCRIPTION:** TPA is located on approximately 3,100 acres on Sparrow's Point, Baltimore Harbor, Maryland. This SB addresses two parcels of property, Parcel A1 and Sub-Parcel B4-1, respectively, located within the 3100-acre site where Bethlehem Steel formerly operated a steel mill. TPA has leased Parcel A1, comprising 48.5 acres, to the FedEx Corporation which is constructing a facility to be used as part of its delivery operations, and has constructed an asphalt car parking lot on Sub-Parcel B4-1, comprising 21 acres, to be used as part of an automotive and distribution center.

**INFORMATION AVAILABLE:** The Administrative Record contains all the documents which EPA considered or relied upon in selecting the proposed remedies.
