

# Facts About...

DUTCH FAMILY DELI OIL SPILL (MD-469)

#### **Site Location**

The Dutch Family Deli was a rest stop located near the intersection of U.S. 301 and Route 291 in Millington, Kent County, MD 21651. The site is located just north of the Chester River. The land use in the area is primarily agricultural and residential, although there are several commercial properties in close proximity to the site.

## **Site History**

An anonymous complaint of an oil spill at the facility led to the site discovery in February 1994.

# **Environmental Investigations**

According to the EPA, a Removal Assessment was conducted on March 1, 1994. There are no records of this assessment. On October 25, 1994, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency conducted a Preliminary Assessment (PA) of the site. This PA is not on file at MDE's at Site Assessment Section. The site was listed as being archived on the same day in EPA's Superfund database.

#### **Current Status**

The site has been archived by EPA, and MDE's Site Assessment Section has placed the site on its "Formerly Investigated Sites" list.
