## Addendum to Proposed Corrective Action Plan

Dear Ms. Bull,

As a preliminary and supplemental effort to the previously proposed Corrective Action Plan dated April 23, 2019, Petroleum Management, Inc. (PMI) would like to propose the following supplemental investigation effort in the area of the storm drain discharge line from the boiler room towards MH Inlet No. 4 to further identify the source of LPH and/or route of entry into the storm drain conduit. PMI is suggesting that we excavate and expose the length of storm drain piping as it exits the boiler room towards MH Inlet No. 4. Once exposed, a confirmation of the piping type and condition can be made, possibly identifying any voids or joints in piping where LPH can enter and migrate and complete any repair or replacement of piping as necessary. Based on previous investigation, it is expected that LPH and contaminated soil will be encountered during this trench work. As LPH is encountered, a vacuum truck will be made available to recover any free liquid. Any contaminated soil encountered will be removed for disposal. Area of excavation is shown on attached Site Plan.

Please review this additional proposal for approval and/or comment. Once approved, a detailed scope of work and cost proposal can be presented to AACPS for approval.
