NOTICES OF FINAL DETERMINATION

The Maryland Department of the Environment's (MDE) Air and Radiation Management Administration, Land Management Administration, and Water Management Administration have each made a final determination on applications submitted by the Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority for the construction and operation of the Frederick/Carroll County Waste-To-Energy Facility at 4549 Metropolitan Ct., McKinney Industrial Park, Frederick, Frederick County, MD 21701. The Department is issuing the Air Quality Permits to Construct, the Non-Attainment New Source Review Approval, the Prevention of Significant Deterioration Approval, the Refuse Disposal Permit and the NPDES permit, including the conditions and emissions limitations presented in the Final Determinations, with an effective date of February 21, 2014.

Pursuant to Section 1-601 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, a final determination by the Department on the issuance of the permits identified above is subject to judicial review at the request of any person that: (1) Meets the threshold standing requirements under federal law; and (2)(i) is the applicant; or (ii) Participated in a public participation process through the submission of written or oral comments.

A petition for judicial review of any of these permits must be filed pursuant to Section 1-605 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland. The petition shall be filed by March 31, 2014 in the Frederick County Circuit Court and otherwise conform to the requirements of Title 1, Subtitle 6 of the Environment Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.
