
## Structure & Oversight

- Funds generated through motor fuel tax and rental car tax in Maryland
- Allocation, targeting, and implementation is a collaborative effort between three partners:
  - BayStat Agencies (DNR, MDA, MDE, MDP, UMD)
  - Scientific Advisory Panel (3<sup>rd</sup> party scientists)
  - The Legislature






## Funding at a Glance

   anticipate \$50M annually












### **FY16 Targeting**



- In 2014, \$995,935 was awarded to 18 projects
- \$1.2 million EPA funds plus rollover will be available for FY16 WAGP






## **EFC Projects**
